Air Marshal Sir Graham Stacey served in the Royal Air Force for almost 40 years in a wide range of appointments, finishing his career as the Chief of Staff of NATO's Allied Command Transformation. Prior to that, in a series of major international appointments, he was the deputy commander of NATO Joint Force Command Brunssum, the commander of British Forces Cyprus and the UK Senior Advisor to US Central Command. He commanded at every level and completed operational service in Northern Ireland, Bosnia, The Gulf, Kosovo, Iraq and Afghanistan. He has extensive experience of leadership and organisational development, innovation, the application of emerging and disruptive technologies, C2 and decision making in multinational environments, and international analysis, strategy and policy. He is currently a Non-Executive Director of the National Centre for Atmospheric Science and undertakes a number of other mentoring, consulting, advising and charity roles.
